During the biennium 2021-2023 the working group continues working on the tasks as stated in the aim in the biennium 2019-2021:

- Title: Facilitating participation and education incl. patient education.
- **Aim:** Education content of this workgroup is based on the ACENDIO constitution and on *Position Statements 4+5*.
- The **product** of this working group is to create a '**Practical Implementation Principles**' on teaching SNLs and eHealth in education (what, how and why).

For the biennium 2019-2021 the working group focused mainly on own experiences and existing curricula in three countries (E, A, NL). Results were presented during the online conference in March 2021.

Based on the polls during the 2021 conference the working group continued work on the aim and decided on working on a format for practical factsheets on educational interventions.
