Conference Theme

The 14th International Conference of ACENDIO explores how nursing-generated data within predictive models can impact patient and organizational outcomes thanks to their focus on key health status elements. This conference highlights the strategies to build predictive models and to integrate eHealth technologies into nursing practice.

Conference Subthemes

- a) Nursing-sensitive patient outcomes related to Standardized Nursing Languages (SNLs), patient adherence and empowering;
- b) Development and validation of SNLs;
- c) Implementation examples of SNLs into curricula, educational methods, models and evaluations;
- d) Implementation of SNLs into practice: methods, examples and evaluations; accuracy of nursing diagnoses, effectiveness of interventions and quality of patient outcomes; decision support systems for nurses and inter-professional teams; effectiveness of usable Electronic Health Records;
- e) Implications of digitalization and ethical concerns;
- f) Usability and effectiveness of digitalization to enhance patient outcomes;
- g) Big nursing data warehousing and research; data interoperability and usability;
- h) Patient safety and quality of care through assistive devices/products;
- i) Documenting nursing care; classifications of nursing diagnoses, interventions and nursing-sensitive patient outcomes; minimum data sets as important part of e-Health;
- j) Quality of artificial intelligence and robotics in nursing to enhance patient outcomes.

The official language of the conference is English. Abstracts must be submitted in English.

Submission of abstracts

We invite you to submit abstracts for the conference according to the following guidelines:

1. Abstracts can be submitted electronically from 12.00 CET on April 25, 2022, via the ACENDIO abstracts link (<https://easychair.org/conferences/?conf=acendio2023>).

All submissions will be acknowledged upon receipt.

2. Submissions may report **original research** that should always relate to the conference theme/subthemes; and must be named accordingly identifying the letter subthemes (see Conference subthemes).

3. Abstracts must be submitted in English and the following formatting guidelines must be adhered to (see also Annex 1):

- Font: Times New Roman, size 12 point with double line spacing;
- Title of presentation should be typed in CAPITAL LETTERS;
- The preferred form of presentation must be indicated: **oral presentation** or **poster presentation**;
- The name(s) of author(s), preceded by initials, to be typed below the title of presentation. The main affiliation should be included for each author. Professional titles, degrees, etc. should not be included;
- The name of the main presenter must be **underlined**, his/her postal address, e-mail address, and phone/fax number must be included.

4. The abstract should be structured as follows:

- **Title**;
- **Keywords** (at least three keywords);
- The **abstract**, which should not exceed 500 words;
- The **abstract** should contain: **Introduction, study/project Aim/s, Methods, Results and Conclusions**. Tables, diagrams and footnotes should be avoided.

5. The scientific committee will consider all abstracts and recommend those for acceptance as oral or poster presentation to the board of ACENDIO. Authors will be notified by email, by October 31st, 2022, of the acceptance/refusal of their submission. Authors, whose abstracts have been selected for presentation, will also be notified of the time, date, method, and allocation of presentation. The acceptance of an abstract implies the conference registration of at least one of the authors. No further correspondence will be entered into this regard. Successful authors are required to register by December 31st, 2022, at the full registration early bird fee.
