Conference Theme

The 15th European Conference of ACENDIO explores the possibilities and experiences with Artificial Intelligence (AI) to benefit nursing and the patient. With experienced keynote speakers we will explore research and education in this area and the effects on nursing outcomes in practice. Besides we will discuss nursing leadership to bring AI in nursing further. Research, education and practical experiences with Standardized Nursing Languages (SNLs) and Electronic Health Records are of course returning topics.

Conference Subthemes

- a) Artificial Intelligence & Nursing; Big nursing data research, including effectiveness of usable Electronic Health Records (EHRs);
- b) Data interoperability and usability of coding systems, Standardized Nursing Terminologies and reference terminologies;
- c) Education, eHealth and AI, Implementation examples of SNLs, eHealth and AI into curricula, educational methods, models and evaluations;
- d) Nursing-sensitive Patient Outcomes related to SNLs, Usability and effectiveness of digitalization and assistive devices to enhance patient outcomes; patient safety and quality of care;
- e) Documenting nursing care, Classifications of nursing diagnoses, interventions and nursing-sensitive patient outcomes; minimum data sets as important part of e-Health;
- f) Accuracy and Prevalence of Nursing Diagnoses, Quality of Patient Outcomes and Effectiveness of Interventions;
- g) Learning Health Systems in Nursing, (re) use of EHR (data) and decision support systems for nurses and inter-professional teams;
- h) Patient participation, adherence and empowering, Implications of digitalization and ethical concerns related to documenting nursing care;
- i) Nursing Prognostics and Advanced Care Planning, clinical reasoning in education and daily practice.

The official language of the conference is English.

Since ACENDIO is, in essence, a network organization the possibility to engage with colleagues in an easy and accessible manner is always highly appreciated. Therefore ACENDIO chose not to offer a hybrid event and the conference will be onsite only.

Submission of abstracts

We invite you to submit abstracts for the conference according the following guidelines:

1. Abstracts must be submitted electronically by 12.00 CET on October 30, 2024, via the ACENDIO abstracts link (<https://app.oxfordabstracts.com/stages/75765/submitter>). All submissions will be acknowledged upon receipt.
2. Submissions may report **original research, project development/evaluation, practice applications or position papers**, and should always relate to the conference theme/subthemes; and must be named accordingly.
3. Abstracts must be submitted in English and the following information is required by the abstract management system:
 - Type of presentation must be indicated: **oral or poster**;
 - Title (max 20 words);
 - The first name(s) and last name(s) of author(s) and their main affiliation (Institution, City, and Country) should be included for each author. Professional titles, degrees, etc. should not be included. The presenting author needs to be indicated using the appropriate box;
 - Choose and indicate conference subtheme which best describes your abstract (see list at page 2).
4. The abstract should be structured as follows:
 - The **abstract**, which should not exceed 500 words.
 - The **abstract** should contain: **Introduction, study/project Aim/s, Methods, Results** (if any) **and Conclusions**. Tables and footnotes should be avoided.
 - **Keywords** that identify your study/project (minimum 2 keywords to a maximum 5 keywords).
5. Permission to publish should be indicated if the submission is accepted for presentation.
6. The scientific committee will consider all abstracts and recommend those for acceptance either as oral/poster presentation to the board of ACENDIO who will make the final decision on the nature of the presentation.
7. Authors will be notified by email, on or before December 30, 2024 of the outcome of their submission. No further correspondence will be entered into this regard.
8. Successful authors are required to register before January 15, 2025 (early bird fee).
9. Authors, whose abstracts have been selected for presentation, will be notified of the time, date, method and allocation of presentation in February 2025.

• Notification of acceptance	December 30, 2024
• Early registration open (early bird fee)	September 30, 2024
• Early registration ends/late registration open	January 15, 2025
• Late registration ends	March 1, 2025
